# **Does Your Nonprofit Need a Business License?**

Many counties and cities require nonprofit organizations to register for a business license, also referred to as a Business Occupational Tax Certificate. Nonprofits should consult their local government to make sure that they are in compliance with all the appropriate requirements. Organizations that do not have a valid and current business license when one is required could be subject to citations, penalties, and fines.

#### **General tips**

- Check with the local government of each county and city where you have a business location or conduct business, even if you are not sure whether your activities in that area trigger the need for a business license.
- Register with the county if you are located or conducting business outside of the limits of an incorporated city. Otherwise, register with the city.
- Always include your 501©(3) status letter with any application for a business license; make sure to tell the person handling your case that you are a nonprofit organization.
- Nonprofits may be exempted from paying occupation taxes, so you should discuss any possible exemptions with the local government issuing each of your business licenses well before taxes are due.
- Most local governments require you to renew your business license every year.
- Make note of upcoming deadlines.
- Review the information below about some of the counties and cities located in the Metro Atlanta area.

• Register with the Business Tax Division. There are no administrative fees.
